

Civil weddings: non-resident foreigners can get married in Peru. There are three main steps before a marriage can go ahead:

- Registration of intent to marry and presentation of the relevant documents
- Publication of the banns
- Issue of marriage license

Couples that wish to travel to Cusco to marry will need to have the following documents certified at the Peruvian Consulate in their home country:

- · Original birth certificate
- Proof of single status
- Proof of residence in the foreign country (utility bills)
- Photocopy of passport


All documents need to be apostilled or authenticated at the Peruvian embassy/consulate.

Shaman weddings: no documents are required as this is a symbolic ceremony which does not have legal value.
